

ATV Training Course

Come join us for an action packed class with topics that will cover basic ATV operation, pre-ride check over, proper riding apparel, safe and responsible trail etiquette, riding on different terrains, basic survival skills, and off road recreational vehicles legal requirements.

An ATV Certificate is a requirement for young riders. Michigan State law requires operators between the ages of 12 and 16 to possess and carry a valid safety training certificate. Access to certain ATV Parks, such as the Mounds and Silver Lake Dunes, and to use an ATV on northern county road right-of-ways are just a couple examples.

Class materials will be provided. The class will consist of workbook exercises, videos, hands on exercises, and class room discussion. At the end of the class, students will be required to take and pass a test to qualify for an ORV Safety Certificate.

The class is broken into two 3 hour sessions. The first half beginning Friday Aug 13th @ 2 P.M. The second half beginning Saturday Aug 14th 9:00am and completing at Noon. This will allow the students to enjoy the majority of the Jamboree events. The class is limited to twenty five students so that we can provide sufficient attention to each student.
