Event Rules...

Registration Rules:

- Riders must conduct themselves in a safe and courteous manner at all times. In the event that any participant is observed operating his/her machine in an unsafe or unsportsmanlike manner he/she may be disqualified and excluded from competition.
- All entrants must sign a **Waiver, Release, and Hold Harmless Agreement** in advance of competition. Any rider under the age of 18 must also have a parent or guardian sign the Waiver.
- ATV riders will be liable for any damage to their ATV, or the property of others during their ride.
- No refunds will be given if the rider chooses not to participate after signup, or is disqualified.
- The St. Helen Chamber of Commerce is not responsible for lost or stolen articles, injury, or property damage.

Equipment Rules:

- Clothing and Gear required - NO EXCEPTIONS. D.O.T. approved helmet, full foot protection, and eye protection must be worn during competition. Contestants must wear foot protection that will completely cover the foot. No sandals or flip-flops. All riders must wear a full-face helmet with shield or helmet with goggles at all times when riding. Helmet & goggles must be strapped on before pulling up to the line. Long pants or other form of leg protection highly recommended.
- ATV's must be in safe mechanical condition to compete. ATVs must have a working Muffler or Silencer, fenders over the rear tires, and a spring return throttle. Drivers must take the responsibility to become aware of the features of the ATV prior to the event, including locations of brakes, throttle, and ignition switch.

GPS Scrabble Ride:

- This is a leisurely ride that involves the use of a GPS unit to locate the event stops. Five sets of GPS coordinates will be provided at the registration desk upon sign-up. The rider proceeds at their own pace to these coordinates in any order they wish. Upon arrival at a coordinate, the rider will find a white board with a “secret” word. This word must be noted. Upon finding all five stops, the rider returns to the Jamboree registration area and provides the “secret words” to a staff member (proving they found the coordinates). The rider will select two letters for each correct “secret word” provided. The object is to:

complete the course visiting all check points noting the five secret words, obtaining 10 letters, 2 for each stop, and forming the best words on a scrabble board with the letters using “JAMBOREE” as the base word.

- Winner of event is determined by the best score for word formed by letters obtained during the ride. Prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the Jamboree for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place.

- Participant may make as many words as possible using the letters they randomly selected. Letters may only be used once. Score based upon letter value used to form the word and the standard Scrabble board scoring. Following chart indicates the letter score followed by the number of letters in each set in parenthesis.

A = 1 (9)	B = 3 (2)	C = 3 (2)	D = 2 (3)	E = 1 (8)	F = 4 (2)

- Letters will be chosen at random by the rider. A slip of paper will be given to the rider indicating the letter selected.

- Each participant must have their own GPS.

- This event may be completed on any day of the Jamboree.

- All riders must receive event instructions at the Registration Tent.

- Event entrants must abide by all terms & conditions on the **Waiver, Release, and Hold Harmless Agreement** or be disqualified. This pertains to operating the ATV under the influence of alcohol, or drugs and the use of protective clothing.

- All event rules are subject to modification as needed to promote fairness in the competition. These rule changes will be due to conditions of the event site, number of racers, and time issues. All rule changes will be announced before the start of the event. • **JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL !!!**
